Saturday Nov 27th

First part this twenty four hours commence with high breeze from E N E and cloudy weather cleared W by S At 2 p m spoke Bark Comodore Morris she got small whale 5 days ago At sun down short in sails Latter part set the sails still cruising employed in vessels duty set up rigging so ends

Sunday Nov 28th

First part this twenty four hours commence with fine breeze from Eastward and fair weather headed S E at sun down short in sails Through the night the same Latter part set the sails and headed her to the Southward so ends

Monday Nov 29th

All this twenty four hours light breeze from E N E and fair weather still cruising Employed in ship duty saw a small sail to the northward so ends

Lat 18° 19 Long 36° 42

Tuesday Nov 30th

All this twenty four hours fine breeze from E N E and good weather still cruising hands employed in ship duty saw two sails and a steamer so ends

Friday Dec 3rd

All this twenty four hours fine breeze from E N E and good weather still cruising employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 17° 10 Long 35° 10

Saturday Dec 4th

All this twenty four hours fine breeze from N E and fair weather headed N W by N hands employed in ship duty still cruising saw one sail so ends
