Sunday Dec 12th

This day commences with fine breeze from Eastward and fair weather wore ship headed to the Northward spoke an English Steamer two days out of Rio our Chronometer his 45 miles out of away keep her off and steered S S E through the night the same At 6 A M saw blackfish and a sail At 9 A M spoke Bark Hadley 120 bbls this season huf to steered W so ends.

Monday Dec 13th

This day commence with fine breeze from S E and good weather steered W At sun down wore ship and steered S S E Middle and Latter part the same hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 21° 37 Long 38° 00

Tuesday Dec 14th

First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from N E and passing clouds steered S S E At sun down short in sails huf to headed E S E At day light steered S E so ends

Lat 22° 45 Long 37° 00

Wednesday Dec 15th

This day commences with fine breeze from E S E and good weather steered S S E At 5 p m spoke Bark Lances 6 months out 100 bbls Through the night headed S E At day light steered S S E hands employed in ship duty so ends.

Thursday Dec 16th

First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from N E and fair weather steered S S E At sun down short in sails huf to headed E S E through the night strong breeze Latter part the same steered S S E saw two sails bound to the Eastward so ends

Lat 24° 47 Long 35° 20

Friday Dec 17th

This day commences with strong N E wind and passing clouds under of short sails steered W by S At sun down huf to headed N N W Latter part fine breeze steered W by S saw two sails bound to Eastward so ends

Lat 25° 7 Long 36° 25

Saturday Dec 18th

This day commences with light breeze from N E and fair weather steered W N W At sun down huf to headed N by W Through the night the same Latter part wore ship headed E by S set the sails employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 25° 10 Long 35° 25

Sunday Dec 19th

This day commences with fine breeze from N E and fair weather steered S W At sun down huf to headed to the Eastward Through the night the same At day light set the sails and steered S W saw grasshops so ends.
