

Remarks on board of Brig

Monday Dec 20th

First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from N.E. and fair weather steered S.W. At sun down huf to and short in sails headed N.E. W. Through the night strong breeze headed N.W. Latter part the same so ends

Lat 25°45 Long 38°04

Tuesday Dec 21st

First part this twenty four hours strong breeze from N.N.E. and passing clouds headed S.W. Through the night the same Latter part more moderate steered S.W. saw one sail employed in repairing the gaff top sail so ends

Lat 26°00 Long 38°50

Wednesday Dec 22nd

This day commences with fine breeze from N.E. and fair weather steered S.W. At sun down huf to and short in sails Through the night wind hauled & headed N.E. by N. Latter part steered N. so ends

Lat 26°05 Long 39°25

Thursday Dec 23rd

This day commences with light breeze from Eastward and good weather steered W. At sun down short in sails huf to headed N.N.E. Through the night the same Latter part strong breeze At 5 A.M. steered S.W. so ends

Lat 25°10 Long 40°40

Friday Dec 24th

This twenty four hours commence with strong breeze from E.N.E. and passing clouds steered S.W. At sun down short in sails huf to headed S.E. & saw several sails through the night the same Latter part strong breeze saw 3 sails so ends

Lat 27°17 Long 40°20

Saturday Dec 25th

This twenty four hours commence with strong breeze from N.E. and passing clouds tack ship and headed N.N.W. at 1 1/2 p.m. spoke Brig Abbott Lawrence 8 months out 180 bbls. At midnight wore ship headed E. Latter part strong breeze from N. N.E. employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 27°06 Long 39°57

Sunday Dec 26th

This day commences with strong breeze from N.N.E. and passing clouds headed E. Middle and Latter part strong breeze At 10 A.M. wore ship headed N.W. saw two sails so ends

Lat 27°23 Long 38°32

Monday Dec 27th

All this twenty four hours strong breeze from N. and smoky weather headed W. N.W. saw Abbott Lawrence to the windward so ends moderating

Lat 27°29 Long 39°24
