Remarks on board of Brig

Tuesday Dec 28th
First part this twenty four hours fresh breeze from Northward and cloudy weather headed W N W Through the night the same Latter part wore Ship headed N E by E so ends
Lat 27° 24 Long 39° 30

Wednesday Dec 29th
First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from Northward and fair weather headed E N E At sun down short in sails Through the night headed to the west and Latter part wore ship headed N E by E so ends
Lat 27° 22 Long 39° 28

Thursday Dec 30th
First part this twenty four hours light breeze from Northward and good weather headed E N E Through the night and Latter part calm hands employed in ship duty so ends
Lat 27° 19 Long 39° 14

Friday Dec 31st
First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from Southward and fair weather steered N N E At sun down lay to and short in sails headed E by N At 3 p m wind hauled E S E headed N E Latter part squally and strong breeze so ends
Lat 26° 17 Long 38° 35

Saturday January 1st New Year
All this twenty four hours fine breeze and good weather headed to N E hands employed in ship duty saw one sail so ends
Lat 25° 28 Long 38° 27

Sunday Jan 2nd
First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from Northward and good weather headed N E by E Middle and Latter part the same saw two sails so ends
Lat 25° 24 Long 37° 14

Monday Jan 3rd
This twenty four hours commence with fine breeze from Northward and good weather headed N E by E At 1 1/2 p m pass by two whales carcass and saw a Bark to the leeward hailing At sun down short in sails Through the night the same Latter part set the sails saw finbacks and grampus so ends
Lat 25° 07 Long 36° 14

Tuesday Jan 4th
This day commence with fine breeze from Northward and good weather steered E S E At 4 p m spoke Bark E. B Phillips 150 bbls this season At sun down short in sails Through the night the same At day light set the sails and headed N E saw 3 sails hands employed in ship duty so ends
Lat 24° 33 Long 35° 46
