Friday Jan 21st

This day commences with fine breeze from N.E. and good weather boats off At 3 p.m. E.B. came on board At 5 p.m. Boat bring the whale long side At 9 p.m. I.B. got her whale long side put up the cutting gear Through the night strong breeze At 4 1/2 A.M. call all hands and commence to cut whale in At 6 strong gale cut a small whale in we parted one the blocks strap and parted the fluck chain from the other one the wind still increasing so ends

Lat 26 20

Long 38 20

Saturday Jan 22nd

This day commence with strong gale from N.E. and heavy sea went on a up on the whale and let it go off from the vessel At 2 p.m. started the fire Through the night fresh gale At 4 a.m. finish boiling Latter part weather the same haul the whale long side and let it go off again so ends

Lat 26 40 Long 38 26

Sunday Jan 23rd

This day commence with fresh gale and heavy sea At 4 p.m. hauled the whale long side weather more moderate commence to cut the whale in Through the night let the whale be long side employed in boiling At day light commence to cut whale in At 10 A.M. finish cutting let the head be long side started the fire commence to boil so ends.

Lat 27 20

Monday Jan 24th

This day commence with fine breeze and good weather employed in boiling Middle and Latter part the same At 8 A.M. commence to work on the head so ends.

Lat 27 40

Long 38 20

Tuesday Jan 25th

This day commence with good breeze and fair weather employed in boiling and working on the head parted the block strap and one the pennants Through the night weather the same At 3 A.M. finish boiling the body At day light made new pennant and new block strap At 8 a.m. commence to work on the head At 11 start the fire so ends boiling

Lat 27 48 Long 38 25

Wednesday Jan 26th

This day commence with fine breeze and good weather employed in boiling & working on the head At 9 p.m. finish boiling Through the night strong breeze Latter part fresh gale employed in stowing the oil on ground tier and pumping the water so ends

Lat 28 05 Long

Thursday Jan 27th

This day commence with fresh gale from North and heavy sea employed in stowing the oil 58 bbls Through the night the same Latter part rainy wind hauled to I.W. steered N.N.E. employed in ship duty no obs. so ends
