Thursday Feb 3rd
This day commence with light breeze from
E N E and rain squalls headed to the
S. At sun down short in sails huf to
headed S E. Through the night the same
Latter part wind N E steered S W employ
ed in making new strap for cutting
pennants saw 3 sails so ends

Friday Feb 4th
This day commence with fine breeze
from N E and fair weather steered
S W took down the old strap and put
up the new ones At sun down wore
ship and short in sails headed N E
Through the night the same Latter part
strong breeze steered W employed in ship
duty so ends.

Lat 26°40 Long 38°35

Saturday Feb 5th
This day commences with fresh breeze
from N E and passing clouds steered
S W Through the night and Latter part
headed N W hands employed in ship
duty so ends

Lat 26°24 Long 39°25

Sunday Feb 6th
All this twenty four hours light breeze
from N E and fair weather headed
N W saw three sails still cruising
so ends.

Monday Feb 7th
This day commence with light breeze
from N N W and cloudy weather head-
ed to Westward At 3 p m wind hauled
to Westward back ship headed N N E
had some rain squalls Through the

Tuesday Feb 8th
First part this day commence with fine
breeze from Eastward and rain squalls
steered W S W At 6 p m wore ship and
huf to headed N by W Middle and Latter
part the same employed in making
spanyarn & ship duty so ends.

Wednesday Feb 9th
First and Middle part this twenty
four hours fresh breeze from N N E and
cloudy weather headed N W Latter
part strong breeze hands employed in
ship duty so ends.

Lat 25°38 Long 42°35

Thursday Feb 10th
First part this day strong breeze from
N E and passing clouds steered W S W
At sun down wore ship huf to headed E by
S Through the night strong breeze Latter
part the same steered S hands employed
in ship duty so ends
