This day commence with strong breeze from N.E. and passing clouds. Steered by E. At sun down hove to headed to the Eastward employed in repairing the fore top mast stay sail. Middle and Latter part fresh breeze from North headed N.E. by E employed in ship duty so ends.

Saturday Feb 12th

This day commences with fresh breeze from North and smoky weather. Headed N.E. by E. Middle part the same. Latter part fine breeze and good weather under of all sails. Hands employed in ship duty so ends.

Lat 27°20 Long 40°22

Sunday Feb 13th

All this twenty four hours fine breeze from N.E. and fair weather. Headed to the Eastward still cruising saw nothing so ends.

Lat 27°44 Long 38°28

Monday Feb 14th

This day commence with fine breeze from N.N.E. and passing clouds. Headed E under of all sails. Through the night strong breeze headed N.E. furled the light sails. Latter part squally parted one the main shrouds reefed the top sail so ends.

This day commence with strong breeze from S.W. and rain squalls. Steered N.N.E. At 5 p.m. wind hauled S.E. Steered N.E. by E. Through the night the same. Latter part light breeze and fine rain so ends.

Lat 25°15 Long 33°30

Thursday Feb 17th

This day commence with light breeze from E.S.E. and cloudy weather. Headed N.E. At sun down short in sails. Through the night the same. Latter part light breeze from Eastward and rainy headed to the Northward so ends no obs.

Friday Feb 18th

This day commences with light breeze from Eastward and calm with rain. Headed to the Northward. At sun down short in sails. Through the night wind hauled S.W. Steered N.E. by E. Latter part the same hands employed in ship duty so ends.
