

Remarks on board of Brig

Monday March 6th

This day commence with fine breeze from S E and good weather steered N E saw two sails Middle and Latter part the same employed in repairing the fore top sail so ends

Lat 5° 10' Long 28° 15'

Tuesday March 7th

This day commence with fine breeze from S E and fine weather steered N E employed in repairing the fore top sail at 12 p m finish it and bent it on Middle and Latter part same employed in repairing the fly jib so ends

Lat 3° 25' Long 27° 54'

Wednesday March 8th

This day commence with fine breeze from S E and fair weather headed N E at 1 p m finish the fly jib and bent it on the fly jib then parted we repair it Middle and Latter part headed N E by E employed in repairing the shrouds of fore rigging so ends

Lat 1° 33' Long 27° 57'

Thursday March 9th

This day commence with light breeze from Eastward and passing clouds headed N N E saw several sails bound to the Southward Middle and Latter part headed N E employed in breaking out for fresh water fill the casks with salt water so ends

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Friday March 10th

This day commence with light breeze from S E and passing clouds steered N E Middle and Latter part the same employed in repairing the main sail so ends

This day commence with light breeze from S E and fair weather steered N E employed in cleaning the windlass Middle part wind hauled to N E headed N by W Latter part the same hands employed in ship duty saw two sails so ends

Lat 2° 16' N Long 27° 50'

Sunday March 12th

This day commence with fine breeze from N E and fair weather headed to the Northward through the night the same Latter part had rain squalls and fine breeze saw one sail bound to the Southward so ends

Lat 3° 35' N Long 28° 52'

Monday March 13th

This day commence with fine breeze from N E and passing clouds steered N W by N 1/2 N Middle and Latter part fresh breeze saw two sails so ends
