Tuesday March 14th

This day commence with fresh N E trades and passing clouds steered N W by N Middle and Latter part strong trades and cloudy so ends.

Lat 9° 11 Long 33° 24

Wednesday March 15th

This day commences with fresh N E trades and passing clouds headed N W by N 1/2 N Middle and Latter part the same so ends

Lat 9° 00 Long 34° 58

Thursday March 16th

This day commence with fresh N E trades and cloudy weather headed N W Through the night the same Latter part headed N by W so ends.

Lat 10° 30 Long 36° 17

Friday March 17th

This day commence with fine N E trades and fair weather headed N Through the night the same Latter part steered N E W wind E N E hands employed in ship duty so ends.

Lat 11° 45 Long 35° 56

Saturday March 18th

This day commence with light breeze from E N E and passing clouds steered N E W At sun down short in sails but headed N by E 1/2 E Latter part set the sails and steered W N W saw several sails bound to the northward so ends

Sunday March 19th

This day commence with fine breeze from Eastward and fair weather steered W N W At sun down short in sails but headed to the northward Through the night the same Latter part fresh breeze steered W by N so ends

Lat 12° 54 Long 39° 42

Monday March 20th

This day commence with fresh N E trades and smoky weather steered W by N At sun down but headed S E by E and short in sails Through the night the same At 5 A.M. spoke Bark E B Phillips got nothing since she came here so ends.

Lat 12° 30 Long 40° 12

Tuesday March 21st

This day commence with fresh N E trades and passing clouds headed N W by N under of short sails Through the night more moderate Latter part fine breeze and good weather employed in breaking out for provision and ship duty so ends

Lat 13° 21 Long 41° 26
