Saturday April 15th

This day commence with fresh breeze from E and passing clouds headed S E employed in set up the fore rigging and fore top mast back stays Middle and Latter part weather the same employed in setting up the starboard the fore top mast rigging saw three sails so ends

Lat 12-30 Long 42-43

Sunday April 16th

All this twenty four hours fresh breeze from Eastward and passing clouds headed to S E At 6 A m tack ship headed N N E at noon more moderate so ends

Lat 11-50 Long 41-49

Monday April 17th

This day commence with fine breeze from eastward and fair weather headed to the northward Through the night the same Latter part employed in working on rigging saw two whales so ends

Lat 13-18 Long 42-18

Tuesday April 18th

This day commence with fine breeze from eastward and good weather headed to the Northward At 4 p m spoke Bark Janet one year out 600 lbs and spoke Bark Lancer she got 310 lbs Middle and Latter part weather the same employed in ship duty the Bark Lancer saw whales here 4 times and got 38 lbs Janet got 10 lbs whale 3 days so ends

Wednesday April 19th

All this twenty four hours fresh breeze from Eastward and passing clouds still cruising hands employed in ship duty saw one sail so ends

Lat 13-20 Long 42-28

Thursday April 20th

All this twenty four hours fresh breeze from E N E still cruising saw three whalers hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 13-00 Long 42-05

Friday April 21st

All this twenty four hours fresh breeze from E N E and passing clouds still cruising saw two sails hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 13-05 Long 42-08

Saturday April 22nd

This day commence with fresh breeze from Eastward and passing clouds still cruising At 3 p m spoke Bark Janet Through the night weather the same Latter part strong breeze hands employed in ship duty saw 3 sails so ends

Lat 13-28 Long 42-05

Cruising of 12-00 and 40-00
