Wednesday May 17<sup>th</sup>

This day commence with fresh trades and passing clouds spoke Brig Abbot Lawrence 20 bbls this season Middle and Latter part still cruising weather the same so employed in black vermishing the iron works so ends.

Lat 13°15' Long 42°47'

Thursday May 18<sup>th</sup>

This day commence with fresh trades and smoky weather saw a Bark to the Eastward bearing N. by E. and Latter part the same so ends.

Friday May 19<sup>th</sup>

This day commence with fresh trades and passing clouds headed to the northward At 4 p.m. spoke Bark Caspary she got through bearing 20 bbls Middle and Latter part headed S. by E. so ends

Lat 13°44' Long 42°32'

Saturday May 20<sup>th</sup>

This day commence with strong trades and cloudy weather steered S. W. by S. At 4 p.m. h'd to headed S. by E. Through the night the same Latter part tack ship and steered N. W. by N. hands employed in ship duty so ends cleaning the windlers.

Lat 12°59' Long 42°50'

Sunday May 21<sup>st</sup>

First used Middle part this day strong breeze and cloudy weather headed to the Northward Latter part steered N. W. saw nothing so ends

Lat 13°44' Long 43°58'

Monday May 22<sup>nd</sup>

This day commence with strong trades and smoky weather steered W. At sundown h'd to headed to the Southward through the night the same At day light steered W. S. W. hands employed in ship duty so ends cleaning the windlers.

Lat 13°07' Long 44°32'

Tuesday May 23<sup>rd</sup>

This day commence with fresh trades and smoky weather steered N. W. Through the night h'd to headed to the northward Latter part steered W. by N. employed in black vermish the windlers saw three sails so ends.

Lat 13°57' Long 45°41'

Wednesday May 24<sup>th</sup>

This day commence with fresh breeze and smoky weather steered W. by N. At 7 p.m. spoke Bark Weathersett 19 months out 20 bbls At 10 1/2 keep her off W. 1/2 N. Latter part the same employed in painting the fore mast so ends

Lat 13°45' Long 47°20'

Thursday May 25<sup>th</sup>

This day commence with fresh breeze and cloudy weather steered W. 1/2 N. employed in painting the fore yard Through the night weather the same Latter part fine breeze employed in painting the jibboom and repaired the fore top mast stay sail so ends

Lat 13°37' Long 49°41'

Cruising on trade winds
