Starboard watch came on board employ-
ed in painting out side so ends.

Wednesday June 6th
Commence with rain squalls finish paint-
ing out side At 6 A.M. watch came on
board the other went shore employed
in put up new stands on main rigging
so ends

Thursday June 7th
All this twenty four hours fine weather
employed in washing the vessel inside
the watch came on board and one of
our crew run away his name his Decker
so ends

Friday June 8th
All this twenty four hours fine weather
employed in finish tarring the rigging
painting & ship duty so ends

Saturday June 9th
All this twenty four hours good weather
send one watch shore on Liberty
employed in painting the vessel inside
so ends

Sunday June 10th
This twenty four hours commence
with rain squalls At 7 A.M. watch
came on board the other went on shore
so ends

Monday June 12th
This day commence with fine weather
watch came on board one man run away
Andrew Jones employed in set up the rig-
ging and & ship duty

Tuesday June 13th
All this twenty four hours fine weather
employed in bending the new sails and

Wednesday June 14th
This day commence with fine weather
employed in getting ready for sea
received 10 lbs of potatoes on board &
so ends

Thursday June 15th
This day commence with weather and
fresh breeze At 8 A.M. got under way
and went of the harbour waiting for the
Capt at noon shore boat come long side
and bring two men Daniel Williams and
D. Floyd so ends this day with 12 hours
to begin sea log

Friday June 16th
This day commence with fresh breeze
and fair weather waiting for Capt
At 5 p.m. Capt came on board set all
sails and steered to the Northward
Middle and Lather part steered N
so ends
