Thursday July 31st 1884

Lat 28.58 N. Fore + middle part of this day calm. Employed
Long 49.16 W. in various ways. B. took out water
Latter part calm.

Friday August 1st 1884

Lat 28.00. Fore + middle part of this day light winds
Long 49.34 from the S. S. C. Brig steering N.W. by N.
Employed in various ways. Latter part calm.

Saturday August 2nd 1884

Lat 28.17 Fore + middle part of this day calm. Employed
Long 49.24 in various ways. One sail in sight
Latter part calm.

Sunday August 3rd 1884

Lat 28.23 Fore part of this day calm. Middle part light
Long 49.37 N. N. E. winds steering N. N. W. One sail in
sight. Latter part light N. E. winds started
with rain squalls. and so ends the day.

Monday August 4th 1884

Lat 28.53 N. Fore part of this day light N. E. winds
Long 50.50 N. Middle part the same. Employed in breaking
out water. Latter part fresh breeze from the N. E.

Tuesday August 5th 1884

Lat 30.26 N. Fore + middle part of this day fresh breeze
Long 51.01 from the N. E. Brig on both tacks by the wind.
Employed in setting up the Port. Main
Rigging. Latter part strong breeze from
the N. E. by E.

Wednesday Aug 6th 1884

Lat 31.34 N. Fore + middle part of this day strong E. S. E.
Long 52.59 W. winds ship on Port tack under short sail
Latter part fresh breeze from E. by N.
Brig on the southern tack.

Thursday Aug 7th 1884

Lat 31.54 N. Fore + middle part of this day fresh breeze from
Long 51.53 W. the Eastward. Brig on the Northern tack.
Employed in various ways. Nothing in
sight. Latter part moderate easterly winds.

Friday Aug 8th 1884

Lat 32.20 N. Fore + middle part light wind from the
Long 51.58 W. Eastward. Employed in setting up the
Port fore rigging. + in taking out
water. Latter part moderate wind from
the Eastward. Brig on the front tack.

Saturday Aug 9th 1884

Lat 31.48 N. Fore + middle part of this day light wind
Long 51.57 W. from the Eastward. Saw two hawks
(whalers) steering to the N. W.
Employed in setting up the Starboard
Fore + Main rigging. Spoke the Scho
Wm. A. Grover of Providence. Latter part
moderate breeze from the Eastward.

Sunday Aug 10th 1884

Lat 31.10 N. Fore + middle part of this day fresh breeze from the E. by S.
Long 52.51 W. Brig on both tacks. Put letter on board of Co. W. S.
A. Grover. 13.15. 13.15. Baker in sight. Spotted
sail at sundown on the Southern tack. Latter part
fresh easterly winds.
