

Remarks on board of

Tuesday Oct 14th 1884

All this day very strong breeze from S. E. by S
Three labourers employed all day & Carpenter
Employed in stripping and reapplying the lead
used 48 sheets of copper of the ship. The Second
mate and Cookman Kane absent without leave
all day

Wednesday Oct 15th 1884

For all this 24 hours strong S. E. winds
Unhooking the masts and found the lower
gudgeon very much worn took it off
Employed in painting ship. 3 Labourers
and 8 Carpenters employed on the ship.
The Second mate and Cookman Kane
have deserted the ship.

Thursday Oct 16th 1884

Strong S. E. winds for all this day. Painting
ship. 3 Labourers and 8 Carpenters employed
on the ship.

Friday Oct 17th 1884

Moderate S. E. winds for all this day
Put on a new gudgeon and hung the
masts. 3 Labourers and 8 Carpenters employed
on the ship.

Saturday Oct 18th 1884

Fine weather with light S. E. wind all this
day. 8 Carpenters employed until 11 O. Clock
A.M. 3 Labourers all day. Hauled the ship
out of the dry docks at 12 O. Clock. Then
finished moving ship at 3 P.M. Employed
the rest of the day in various ways
Received in all 392 sheets of 15 acres copper

Sunday Oct 19th 1884

For all this day fine weather with wind at
N. E.

Monday Oct 20th 1884

For all this day fresh S. W. winds. Employed
in getting water in the forenoon and pump
the water boat in the afternoon. 4 Labourers
employed all day

Tuesday Oct 21st 1884

Strong S. W. winds for all these 24 hours
Employed in taking water and in stowing
the hold. 4 Labourers to day. Took Fuller down to
the ship. Took Williams from the ship as
Second officer.

Wednesday Oct 22nd 1884

All this day moderate west winds employed
in getting water and in stowing hold.
4 Labourers employed to day. Ship 48 bunnies
of copper and one barrel

Thursday Oct 23rd 1884

For all this day strong N. W. wind employed
in finishing taking water and stowing hold
4 Labourers employed to day.

Friday Oct 24th 1884

For all this 24 hours strong N. W. wind
Employed in getting ready for sea
2 Labourers. Employed to day. Received
a lot of Potatoes and other vegetables. Berardo
Bastie deserted the ship. Discharged
all labourers to night
