

Remarks on board of

Monday Dec 8th 1884

Lat 18.40 N For the fore and middle part of this day fresh East winds. By the wind on the port tack. Employed in making out provisions. One large turtle passed us today. Weather part moderate E. N. E. wind. Brig by the wind on the Starboard tack.

Tuesday Dec 9th 1884

Lat 20.27 N For the fore and middle part of this day fresh East winds, by the wind on both tacks. Set up the Starboard main rigging. Main topmast head and back stays. Broke out bread and flour. Saw 1 Black Duck this afternoon. Weather part moderate E. N. E. wind. By the wind on both tacks.

Wednesday Dec 10th 1884

Lat 22.54 N For all this 24 hours moderate East wind by the wind on both tacks. Employed in setting up the fore stay and various other ways.

Thursday Dec 11th 1884

Lat 20.44 N For the fore and middle part of this day moderate E. N. E. wind by the wind on the fore part under short sail and steering N. or by N for the middle part. At 4.45 saw a spot on the Port bow did not make them out. Weather part by the wind on both tacks.

Brig C. H. Adams

Friday Dec 12th 1884

Lat 23.55 N The fore part of this day began with moderate E. N. E. Middle part wind E. by N. with squally weather. Employed in bracing out the fore hold. Brig steering various courses and by the wind. Broke out 2 boxes of canned beef. Weather part by the wind on the fore tack.

Saturday Dec 13th 1884

Lat 20.02 N For the fore and middle part of this day fresh trade with very squally weather. Employed in repairing the main sail. Brig by the wind on the southern tack. Weather part strong E. N. E. wind with squally sea.

Sunday Dec 14th 1884

Lat 20.24 N For the fore part of this day fresh trade with E. N. E. Middle part increased to a strong breeze with very sharp sea running. Brig by the wind on opposite tacks under short sail. At 4.30 P. M. reefed the fore top sail. Weather part fresh gale E. wind from the E. N. E. The Brig is leaking about 900 shooks per day in rugged weather.

Monday Dec 15th 1884

Lat 20.36 N For the fore and middle part of this day fresh gale from the E. N. E. with heavy sea. Brig on both tacks by the wind under short sail. Weather part moderating to a strong breeze.
