

Wednesday April 1st 1888

This day begins with a brisk S.W. wind. Starting 6. M. at sundown
 luffed to the wind on the Port tack
 and layed aback. Day & had bearing
 N. E. by compass. about 6 miles distance.

For the middle part laying of and on the
 Sore & Rigs Light Ship. Took the
 Pilot at 5. A. M. and came to the anchorage
 at 10. A. M. And so ends the voyage.
