There personally appeared before me, G. B. Carter, master of the Schooner "Noramtega," of Bangor, who on oath deposes and says that the said vessel sailed from Philadelphia, Pa., on the second day of August current, bound to Edgartown and Boston with a cargo of 500 tons cast iron pipe, 150 tons of which was consigned to L. E. Hawes of Edgartown and the remainder to Boston. The voyage proceeded well and without incident up to the 5th inst. when a heavy sea from the south was encountered, causing vessel to roll and labor heavily and shift cargo and in anticipation of damage to said cargo thereby the said G. B. Carter hereby notes this as his protest to be extended at some future time if necessary.
