Fragier in Site Middle and latter part headed
to the North So Ends
Lat 20 12 Long 23 55

Saturday Nov 7 Comes With good Breeze
and Clear Weather Brig heading to the North
all Sail out Middle part took in Sail latter
part made Sail and headed S W
3 Sails in Site So Ends
Lat 20 18 Long 24 35

Sunday Nov 8 Begins With good Weather
and light Breeze Brig heading S W all Sail
out Middle part took in Sail latter
part made Sail and headed S E Fragier
in Site So Ends
Lat 19 52 Long 23 51

Monday Nov 9 Comes With good
Weather Brig heading E S E all Sail
out middle and latter part headed N W
So Ends Lat 20 00 Long 25 01

Tuesday Nov 10 Comes With light N E
Winds and Clear Brig heading off N W
N Middle part took in Sail and came
to the Wind latter part headed West all
Sail out So Ends
Lat 20 00 Long 25 35

Wednesday Nov 11 Comes With good
Weather Clear Brig heading S W middle
part made Back Fragier in Site latter
part Calm So Ends
Lat 19 45 Long 26 00

Thursday Nov 12 Comes With Calm Weather
middle part the same latter part light air from
N W W Brig heading W S W. Saw Blackfish
and got 3 So Ends
Lat 19 25 Long 26 35

Friday Nov 13 Comes With light Winds from
the North Brig heading W S W Fragier in
Site Middle part took in Sail latter part
made Sail and headed S W So Ends
Lat 19 05 Long 27 05

Saturday Nov 14 Comes With light Winds
and Clear Weather Brig heading W S W all
Sail at 6 took in Sail and made Back on
Starboard tack latter part headed West
and were bound to E S E Sail the Blackfish
So Ends Lat 18 20 Long 27 11

Sunday Nov 15 Comes With light Winds
and Clear Weather Brig heading E S E at
6 took in Sail latter part headed the same
all Sail out So Ends
Lat 18 08 Long 26 43

Monday Nov 16 Comes With light air from
N E Brig heading to the North all Sail out
middle and latter part the same Fragier
in Site and 2 Sails So Ends
Lat 18 56 Long 27 20

Tuesday Nov 17 Comes With light Winds
and Clear Weather Brig heading to the North at
6 PM were bound to S E middle part Squally
Whales latter part Clear Weather Saw School of Spum
Whales going to the East quick here
the Starboard and West boats got none
So Ends
Lat 18 36 Long 26 41
