and headed to the S E latter part made
West all Sail out 2 Sails in Sight So Ends
Lat 19 00 Long 25 35

Monday Nov 30 - Comes With good Breeze
and Clear Weather Brig heading N N W
all Sail out at 6 P M took in Sail
and headed to the North latter part
made all Sail and headed S E Spoke the
Schooner Batten So Ends
Lat 19 15 Long 26 07

Tuesday December 1 1885
Comes With good Hot Sail Breeze and Hazy
Weather Brig heading S E all Sail out
2 Sails in Sight at 6 P M took in Sail
and headed the Same latter part headed South
Spoke C W Morse Batten in Sight So Ends
Lat 18 20 Long 25 16

Wednesday Dec 2 - Comes With light
Winds and Clear Weather Brig heading South
all Sail out at 6 P M took in Sail and headed
S E latter part the Same Morse in Sight
So Ends Lat 17 40 Long 24 40

Thursday Dec 3 - Comes With light Winds
and Thick Weather Brig heading to the North
all Sail out 2 Sails in Sight Middle
and latter part the Same So Ends
Lat 19 00 Long 25 15

Friday Dec 4 - Comes With good Hot
Sail Breeze Thick Weather Brig heading
North all Sail out at 7 P M took in
the Light Sails Middle part the
Same latter part took to the S E
one Sail in Sight So Ends
Lat 19 50 Long 25 23

Saturday December 5 1885

Comes With Strong Breeze and Clear Weather
Brig heading S E Under Fore top sail Flygib
Main Sail at 6 P M took in the Main sail
Flygib and Reefed the Top sail Middle part
the Same latter part at the Flygib and
took the Reef out the Top sail Saw a Steamer
So Ends Lat 19 00 Long non

Sunday Dec 6 - Comes With Strong
Winds and Very dark Weather Brig
heading E S E at 4 P M took in Flygib
and Reefed the Fore Top sail Middle part took
in the Gib and Fore sail at 6 A M Saw some kind
of Whales did not make out what they was and
were bound to the N W and made Sail So Ends
Lat 18 40 Long 24 00

Monday Dec 7 - Comes With Strong Winds and
Cloudy Weather Brig heading North Lat the
Fore top galant sail and Flygib at 4 P M
took them in and Reefed the Top sail at 7 were
bound to S E Middle and latter part the Same
So Ends Lat 18 20 Long 23 46

Tuesday Dec 8 - Comes With Strong Winds and Clear
Weather Brig heading S E by S Under Hot Top sail
Flygib at 5 P M were bound to N W E and took in
the Flygib Middle part the Same latter part
made all Sail and headed by the Wind N N W
Saw 2 Steamers So Ends
Lat 19 20 Long 24 21

Wednesday Dec 9 - Comes With good Breeze
and Clear Weather Brig heading N N W all Sail
out Brake out Reefed and Water Middle and
latter part light air and calm Saw 2 Steamers
So Ends Lat up the head gear So Ends
Lat 19 26 Long 24 19
