 Comes With good Breeze from S E and
 clear Weather at 1 P M tack to the S W
 all Sail out middle and latter part the
 same one Sail in sight So ends

Thursday July 15 1856
 Comes With light Winds and clear
 Weather Brig heading E by N all Sail
 out at 3 P M saw one Sperm
 Whale saw the two Boats and
 W. Boat struck at 4 took the Whale
 to the Ship and cut it in at 7 got
 three middle part headed the same
 latter lighted the Fire So ends

Friday July 16 1856
 Comes With light Winds and clear
 Weather Brig heading S S W and
 Bojling at 7 P M took in Sail and
 headed the same latter part got three
 Bojling at 7 A M tack to E S E made
 all Sail So ends

Saturday July 17 1856
 Comes With light Winds from S E
 and clear Weather Brig heading E N E
 at 7 P M took in the light Sails
 middle part calm latter part light airs
 from S E stow the oil down So ends

Sunday July 18 1856
 Comes With light S E Winds and clear
 Weather Brig heading S S W all Sail out
 middle part headed E N E latter part
 headed S S W So ends

Monday July 19 1856
 Comes With light S E Winds and clear
 Weather Brig heading S W by S all
 Sail out at 7 P M took in Sail and
 headed the same came with squalls at
 9 A M saw Sperm Whales bore the 3 Boat
 the W. B. struck and took the Whale to the
 Brig and butted in So ends

Tuesday July 20 1856
 Comes With light Winds from South and
 Rain squalls Brig heading W S W all Sail
 out at 7 P M took in Sail and headed
 the same latter part wore Round to the
 S E at 7 A M came to Bojling saw one
 Sail So ends

Wednesday July 21 1856
 Comes With light Winds from South and
 clear Weather Brig heading East all Sail
 out at 7 P M took in Sail and headed
 West middle and latter part the same saw
 Sperm Whales heading East bore the Boats
 and the Boat struck and got one the other
 got none one Sail in sight So ends

Thursday July 22 1856
 Comes With strong Breeze and clear Weather
 Brig heading S E and cutting at 6 P M
 got three and took in Sail and stow oil
 down middle and latter part headed on different
 tacks and Bojling So ends

Friday July 23 1856
 Comes With light Winds and clear Weather
 Brig heading W N W all Sail out and
 Bojling at 7 took in Sail middle and
 latter part calm saw Whales and stow
 the oil down
