

Saturday July 24 1886
 Comes with calm weather saw Whales
 saw the 3 Boats and Starboard Boat
 struck but the iron came out at 8 PM
 came Board latter part calm so ends
 Lat 31.16 Long 55.24

Sunday July 25
 Comes with calm weather and
 clear middle and latter part
 light air from E S E Brig heading
 South so ends
 Lat 31.00 Long 55.20

Monday July 26
 Comes with light air from S E
 and squally Brig heading North all sail out
 at 7 PM took in sail and laid back
 middle part the same latter part headed
 E by N at 6 AM saw sperm whales
 heading to the S E and going quick
 saw the 3 Boats but got no solid
 Lat 31.21 Long none

Tuesday July 27
 Comes with light air from S E and
 clear weather Brig heading E by N
 Boats down chasing Whales at 8 PM
 came Board middle part the Whales came
 round the Brig latter part headed on different
 tacks all sail out so ends seen nothing
 Lat 31.30 Long 55.02

Wednesday July 28
 Comes with good breeze from S S E and
 clear weather Brig heading on different
 tacks to the windward all sail out at 7
 PM took in sail middle part headed S W
 latter part headed E N E all sail out
 at 7 PM saw sperm Whales going quick
 to S E and saw another school to
 leeward saw 3 Boats L.B. got 1 S.B. 1
 W.B. lost her Lat 31.41 Long 55.14

Thursday July 29 1886
 Comes with light S E Winds and clear weather
 Brig heading E N E cutting at 2 PM got
 three and headed to the S W Under Short
 sail spoke the Schooner W H Groeger Baine
 home Capt Sack at 6 AM saw sperm Whales
 4 miles off going quick to the South and not
 saw the Boats at 8 they was out of sight
 so ends Lat 31.58 Long 54.12
 53.42

Friday July 30
 Comes with light S E Winds and clear
 weather Brig heading W all sail out
 and backing middle and latter part the same
 got three backing and then some oil down
 so ends Lat 31.18 Long 54.50

Saturday July 31
 Comes with light Winds and clear weather
 Brig heading West all sail out at 7 PM took
 in sail and laid back middle part the same
 latter part headed N W and North saw one sail
 so ends Lat 30.59 Long 55.19

Sunday August 1 1886
 Comes with good breeze from S S E and
 clear weather Brig heading to the N N E
 all sail out at 7 PM took in sail and
 laid back middle part the same latter part
 headed of on different tacks to the North one
 sail in sight so ends
 Lat 31.45 Long 55.08

Monday Aug 2
 Comes with light winds from South
 and clear weather Brig heading off to the
 N W all sail out at 7 PM took in sail
 and headed West middle part the same
 latter part headed S S E all sail out
 Wind S W so ends
 Lat 31.40 Long 55.04

The Cho - was 30 miles to the Westward
