

Thursday September 3rd 1886
 Comes With Strong Winds from N E and
 Squally Weather Brig heading North Under
 Short Sail at 7 P M Wore Round to the
 S E Middle and latter part Squally
 Weather Spoke to Schooner Pedro Varela
 So Ends Lat 31.30 Long 41.21

Friday Sept 4
 Comes With light E N E Winds and
 clear Brig heading S E all Sail out at
 7 P M took in Sail and headed the same
 Middle and latter part light air and calm
 3 Sails in sight Saw Blackfish some
 and got one So Ends
 Lat 31.15 Long 40.46

Saturday Sept 5
 Comes With light air from N E
 Brig heading S E all Sail out at 7
 P M took in Sail and made a back Black
 fish Round the Brig Middle and latter
 part the same So Ends
 Lat 31.00 Long 40.51

Sunday Sept 6
 Comes With light East Winds and clear
 Weather Brig heading to the North all Sail out
 Middle part the same latter part Saw
 Sperm Whales at 9 A M Slew the Boats
 and got 2 - L B H B So Ends
 Lat 31.40 Long 41.08

Tuesday Sept 7
 Comes With light Winds from E N E
 and clear Weather at 3 P M took the
 Whales to the Brig and cut them in
 at 7 got Three Middle and latter part
 Cut up the Blubber and Carcass to Boil
 Saw one Sail Brig heading to the North
 Wind S E So Ends
 Lat 31.32 Long 41.19

Wednesday September 8th 1886
 Comes With calm Weather Brig heading middle
 and latter part the same Saw one Sail
 Pump out Water and Stow down Oil So Ends
 Lat 31.54 Long 41.18

Thursday Sept 9th
 Comes With light air from N W and
 clear Brig heading N W and Bojling
 at 10 P M got Three Bojling latter part
 Stow the oil down 3 Sails in sight So Ends
 Lat 31.58 Long 41.14

Friday Sept 10
 Comes With good Breeze from N W E and
 clear Brig heading East all Sail out at 7
 P M took in Sail and headed the same
 Middle part the same latter part calm
 So Ends Lat 32.04 Long 41.24

Saturday Sept 11
 Comes With calm and clear Weather
 Mended the main Stay Sail Middle and
 latter part the same Saw Blackfish
 So Ends Lat 32.12 Long 41.11

Sunday Sept 12
 Comes With light air and calm Brig heading
 S E Middle part and latter part the
 same Saw Porpoise one Sail in sight
 So Ends Lat 32.23 Long 40.58

Monday Sept 13
 Comes With calm and clear Weather
 Middle and latter part the same
 got the Foretop sail down to Mandet
 So Ends
 Lat 32.24 Long 41.23
