

Friday, November 5 1886
Comes With Strong East Winds Brig heading
N.W. Under Short Sail at 6 left too
on the Port Tack Middle part the same
latter part headed off West saw one Steamer
So ends Lat 19.08 Long 24.30

Saturday Nov 6
Comes With Strong Breeze from E N E
and Buggy Weather Brig heading S W at
6 P M took in sail and headed S E Middle
part the same latter part headed off S W
Saw several Sails So ends
Lat 18.25 Long 25.12

Sunday Nov 7
Comes With good Breeze from N E and
foggy Brig heading N W all sail out at
6 P M took in sail and headed S E Middle
and latter part headed on different Tacks to
the Westward Saw Blackfish So ends
Lat 18.10 Long 25.40

Monday Nov 8
Comes With good all sail Breeze from
N E and clear Weather Brig heading S W
all sail out at 6 P M took in sail
and made back Middle part the same
latter part headed South San Antonio Island
5 miles bearing East So ends

Tuesday Nov 9
Comes With good Weather Brig on the
West Side of San Antonio in calm one
Whaling Schooner in sight Middle
and latter part the same Land 15
miles off E N E at 6 P M spoke the
Schooner latter E Cook So ends

Wednesday November 10 1886
Comes With Baffling Winds Brig heading
N W Under Short Sail Middle part
the same latter part headed North at
6 P M spoke the Gage St Thillepps So ends
Lat 17.40 Long non

Thursday Nov 11
Comes With Strong Breeze from N E Brig
heading to the North middle and latter part
the same So ends
Lat 18.30 Long 26.35

Friday Nov 12
Comes With good Breeze from E N E and
clear Brig heading to the North all sail out
at 6 P M tack to S E and took in the
light Sails & Sails in sight middle
the same latter part headed North 2 Schooners
in sight Saw Blackfish and got one to end
Lat 18.40 Long 26.18

Saturday Nov 13
Comes With good Breeze from E N E
and clear Weather Brig heading North all
sail out at 6 took to S E and took in
the light Sails Middle part the same
latter part headed to the North Under
Short Sail Several Sails in sight
Saw Brackets to the Windward So ends
Lat 18.35 Long 26.35

Sunday Nov 14
Comes With Strong Winds and clear Brig
heading on different Tacks Under Short
Sail Middle and latter part the same Strong
Winds and Squalls So ends
Lat 19.44 Long 25.27
