

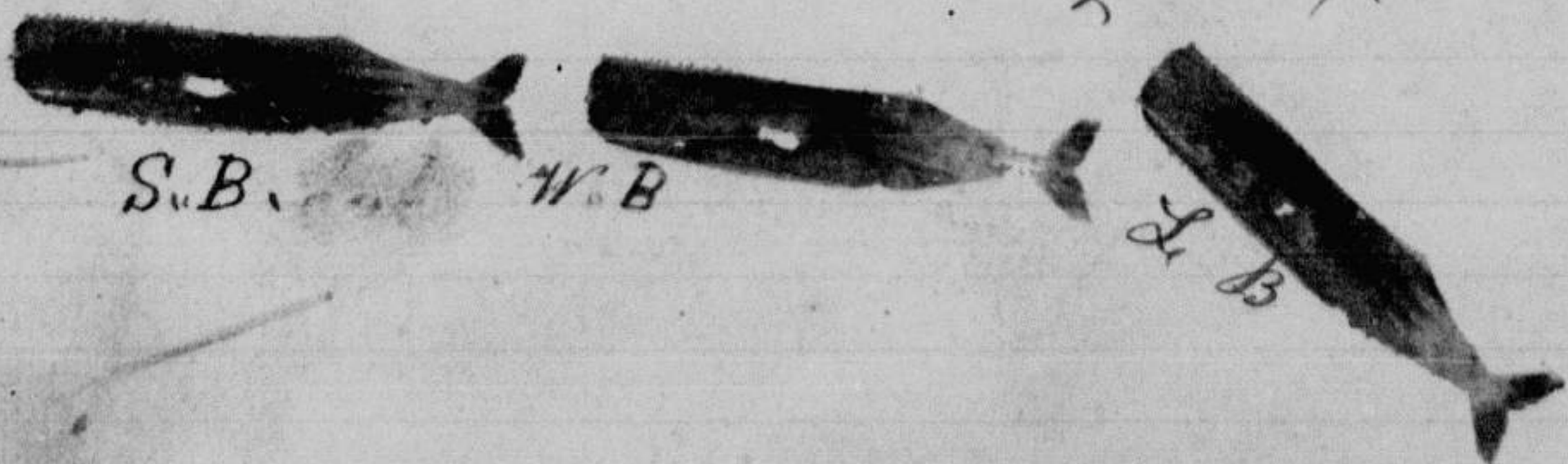
Sunday, December 26<sup>th</sup> 1886  
 Comes with good Breeze from S E and  
 foggy weather Brig heading to the North at  
 8 PM took in sail and Lade Back Middle  
 part the same latter part headed N. W  
 all sail out spoke Ship British Geoman  
 of Liverpool Bound to San Francisco 13-  
 days out So ends  
 Lat 18.40 Long 25.47

Monday Dec 27  
 Comes with light Winds from East Brig  
 heading to the North all sail out at 6  
 took in sail and headed the same middle  
 part the same latter part made all sail  
 and headed N. W. W. two sails in sight  
 and made the fore sail So ends  
 Lat 19.10 Long 26.12

Tuesday, Dec 28  
 Comes with light East Winds and cloudy  
 Brig heading N. W. all sail out the fore  
 sail on tack mending at 7 P. M.  
 Calm down took in sail middle part  
 Rainy latter part good Breeze and cloudy  
 weather Brig headed S. E. all sail out  
 set the fore sail So ends  
 Lat 18.50 Long none

Wednesday Dec 29  
 Comes with good Breeze from S E and  
 cloudy Brig heading South at 6 P. M.  
 Shallop sail and headed the same middle  
 and latter part moderate weather Brig  
 heading to the South all sail out So ends  
 Lat 17.35 Long 25.48

Thursday, December 30 1886  
 Comes with light Winds from S E  
 and clear weather Brig heading S E by E  
 all sail out at 4 P. M. Saw Sperm Whales  
 Score and S. B. struck them L. B. struck  
 W. B. at 9 P. M. took the Whales  
 to the Brig took in sail at day light  
 but the Whales in at 11 A. M. got three  
 one sail in sight So ends  
 Lat 17.42 Long 26.05

Friday, Dec 31  
 Comes with light East Winds and  
 clear weather Brig heading to the North  
 cutting up the Blubber at 5 P. M. got  
 two more bound to S E and started  
 the works middle part the same latter  
 part headed S E all sail out saw  
 Blackfish saw the boats got none  
 turn the S. Boat Button up to mend  
 got stove by a Whale So ends the  
 Year 1886

Lat 17.35 Long 25.48
