 heavy Squall on at 3 P M took the Whales
 to the Brig and but over in middle
 part Laid Back two Whales along side
 latter part but them in and headed S E
 all Sail out No Ends

Friday Jan 7th
 Comes With light Northerly Winds and
 clear Weather Brig heading E S E all Sail
 out at 5 P M took in Sail and headed
 N W by the Wind and at 6 Started the
 Works latter part the same Strong Winds
 No Ends Lat 17.09 Long 26.06

Saturday Jan 8th
 Comes With Strong Winds from N E
 and Cloudy Brig heading to the North
 Under Short Sail at 6 P M gut Throo
 Bayling and Stow down some oil middle
 part Fresh gale and latter part Squally
 Weather San Sperm Whales going to
 the Windward did not bore No Ends
 Lat 17.40 Long 26.35

Sunday Jan 9th Comes With
 Fresh gale from East and Squally
 Weather Brig heading on different tracks Under
 Short Sail San Sperm Whales going to the
 Windward did not bore middle part headed S E
 latter part to the North Lat 17.25 Long 26.14
