Comes With Fresh gale from E N E and
cloudy Weather Brig heading North Under

at 6 P M Wore Ship to S E Middle

the boats and got 3 B. B. L. B. W. B.
Francis A Barston got Whales So ends

Thursday Jan 13

Comes With Strong Winds Brig heading
to the North with 4 Whales to the
Ship and cut one in and two lay
Long Side took in Sail for the Night
latter part Fresh gale from N E cut
one Whale in and started on the other
So ends

Lat 17.06 Long 26.110

Friday January 14 1887
Comes With Strong Winds from the N E
and heavy Squall on at 3 P M got
Three cutting and cut the heads up
and wore Round to S E Middle part
Comes to Bay's latter part cut up the
Blubber So ends
Lat 16.50 Long 26.08

Saturday Jan 15

Comes Comes With light N N E Winds
and cloudy Brig heading N N by the
Wind and Bay's Long. Saw some oil down
Middle part and latter part calm
Brook out Water and saw oil So ends
Lat 16.58 Long 26.30

Sunday Jan 16

Comes With light air and calm Brig
heading to the North and Bay's at 9
P M got Three Bay's Long. Middle part saw
oil down latter part the same So ends
Lat 18.00 Long 27.16

Monday Jan 17

Comes With light Winds and cloudy Weather
Brig heading North all sail out Finck
Staving down at 4 P M took to S E
Middle and latter part the same Weather
Ported the Fore top mast Back stay and
Spleet So ends
Lat 18.00 Long 26.33

Tuesday Jan 18

Comes With light air from East Brig
heading to the North one sail in sight
at 6 P M calm down took in the light
Sails Middle part the same latter part
light Winds from E N E Brig heading
to the North all sail out So ends
Lat 17.25 Long 26.44
