 Comes With Strong Breeze from East and
 Foggy Weather Brig heading S S E Under
 Short Sail at 6 P M took in Sail and
 Luff to the Wind Middle part the same
 latter part made the Island of Brava and at
 12 noon came to Anchor on the West
 Side Brava So ends

Friday Feb 11
 Comes With good Weather the man
 Painting, latter part the same So ends

Saturday Feb 12
 Comes With good Weather the man
 Lay down in Rigging, latter part the
 same So ends

Sunday Feb 13
 Comes With good Weather Brig at
 Anchor on West Side of Brava So ends

Monday Feb 14
 the same took a Board some
 Potatoes for Blackfish oil So ends

Tuesday Feb 15
 Comes With good Weather Trading for
 Potatoes at 6 AM took the Anchor and
 came to Sea So ends
 Jorge Batista departed at Brava and
 took Manuel Alves in his Place

Wednesday February 16 1887
 Comes With calm Weather Brig on
 West Side of Brava 25 miles off
 latter part good Breeze heading S S E
 all Sail out So ends
 Lat 14 25 Long 24 00

Thursday Feb 17
 Comes With good Breeze from E N E and
 Smoky Weather Brig heading S S E all Sail
 out latter part Strong Winds took in
 the Fore-gallant Sail and Gaff top-sail So ends
 Lat 14 10 Long 22 49

Friday Feb 18
 Comes With Strong Winds from N E and
 Cloudy Brig heading S E Haul Top-sail
 and Main Sail Started a Leach
 forward on the Bow Middle and latter
 part the same So ends
 Lat 12 10 Long 22 49

Saturday Feb 19
 Comes With Strong Winds and Clear
 Weather Brig heading S E Under
 Short Sail Middle and latter part
 the same So ends
 Lat 11 10 Long 20 40

Sunday Feb 20
 Comes With Strong Breeze from
 E N E and Clear Brig heading S E
 Under Short Sail Middle and latter
 part Moderate Weather heading S S E
 all Sail out So ends
