 Keaparet So Ends
 Lat 16 12 Long 39.37

Wednesday March 16
 Comes With light N & E Winds and clear
 Weather Brig heading North all Sail out
 at 6 PM took in the Light Sails
 middle and latter part headed North all Sail
 out So Ends Lat 16.45 Long 40.01

Thursday March 17
 Comes With light Winds and clear Weather
 Brig heading North all Sail out at 6 PM
 took in the light Sails and headed the same
 middle and latter part the same Saw Black
 fish and gut 4 L B, 1 W B, 1 S & 2
 So Ends Lat 17.15 Long 40.17

Friday March 18
 Comes With light Winds and clear Weather
 Brig heading to the North at 6 PM took in
 Sail middle part headed North latter part
 S & E all Sail out So Ends
 Lat 17.04 Long 39.44

Saturday March 19
 Comes With light Winds and clear Weather
 Brig heading S & E all Sail out at 6 PM
 took in the light Sails and headed the
 same latter part the same Bayl the Black
 fish and at 5 PM Saw School of Sperm
 Whales heading West saw the Boats but
 got none to late we Sail in sight
 So Ends
 Lat 16 03 Long 38.42
