 Lat 16° 04' Long 38° 53'

Tuesday April 5
 Comes With Calm and Clear Weather
 Middle and latter part light Winds from
 the North Brig heading N.W. all Sail out
 Saw Hump Back So Ends
 Lat 16° 00' Long 39° 34'

Wednesday April 6
 Comes With light Winds from N.E.
 and Clear Weather Brig heading N.W.
 at 6 took in Sail and headed N.W.
 Middle part the same latter part S.E.
 all Sail out So Ends
 Lat 15° 56' Long 39° 21'

Thursday April 7
 Comes With light N.E. Winds and
 Clear Weather Brig heading S.E. all Sail
 out at 6 P.M. took in the Light Sails
 Middle part the same latter part made
 all Sail and Saw Whales at 8 A.M.
 heading S.W. Saw two Boats and
 one Sail in Light
 one Sail in Light
 The Windward Boat Whales going to fast
 came back L.B. got all rock to
 Pleases and turn over L.B. got
 Shore on the same Whale and the
 Mate and L. Mate in the W.B. Reel the
 Whale and came off with L.B. and
 Peck the other up So Ends

Friday April 8 1887
 Comes With light Winds and Clear Weather
 at 4 P.M. took the Whale to the Brig
 and cut him in at 6 P.M. gut Throo.
 and headed to the S.E. Under Short Sail
 latter part headed North all Sail out and Bojling
 So Ends Lat 15° 28' Long 38° 51'

Saturday April 9
 Comes With light N.E. Winds and Clear
 Weather Brig heading N.W. all Sail out
 at 6 P.M. took in the Light Sails and
 tack to S.E. and Bojling latter part
 took the Stern Boat out and put the other
 back and gut Throo Bojling at 11 A.M. So Ends
 Lat 15° 33' Long 38° 55'

Sunday April 10
 Comes With light Winds and Clear Weather
 Brig heading to the North all Sail out and
 the man Staving oil down at 6 P.M. gut Throo
 took in Sail and headed S.E. latter part
 North Under Winds So Ends
 Lat 15° 56' Long 39° 10'

Monday April 11
 Comes With Strong Breeze from N.E.
 and Clear Brig heading to the North
 Under Short Sail Middle part None
 Round to S.E. latter part the same all
 Sail out manning the 1st Boat So Ends
 Lat 15° 45' Long 38° 34'

Tuesday April 12
 Comes With good old Sail Breeze and Clear
 Weather Brig heading S.E. all Sail out
 at 6 P.M. took in Sail and headed the same
 latter part headed North one Sail in Light
 Saw a British to the Windward So Ends
 Lat 15° 13' Long 38° 11'
