to the Westward Brig heading to the
N.W. Under Short Sail Middle
and latter part Rain Squally Saw a
Sperm Whale and Killers a Round
him Saw the Boats but did not get
lost the Whale Went to the Windward
Spoke Schooner Baltic So Ends
Lat 34.35 Long 73.18

Saturday July 30
Comes With Strong Winds and Squally
Weather Brig heading N.W. all Sail
out Sat up the Back Stays and Flygels
Stay Sch in Sight Middle and latter
part the Same Saw Blackfish and Porpoise
3 Sails in Sight So Ends
Lat 36.20 Long 74.00

Sunday July 31
Comes With Strong Winds from S.W.
and Squally Weather Brig heading to the
North Under Short Sail at 4 P.M.
took in and Laid Back on Port
tack Middle and latter part Squally Weather
Spoke the Schooners E.B. Conuell Baltic
Agate and Mary G. Curran Brig heading to
the Westward So Ends
Lat 37.07 Long 74.18

Monday August 1 1887
Comes With light Winds and Squally
Weather Brig heading to the Westward
Under Short Sail Schs in Sight
Middle part the Same latter part headed
S.E. all Sail out the Schooners
in Sight So Ends
Lat 36.50 Long 73.56

Tuesday August 2nd 1887
Comes With good Breeze from S.W. and
Cloudy Brig heading S.E. at 4 P.M. tack to
the N.W. at 7 took in Sail and headed N.W.
by N. Conuell in Sight Middle and latter
part Strong S.W. Winds and Cloudy Saw
Several Vessels So Ends
Lat 37.07 Long 74.19

Wednesday Aug 3
Comes With Fresh Gale from S.W.
and Cloudy Weather Brig heading W.
N.W. at 5 P.M. Wore Round to
S.S.E. Under Close Reefed and took
up the Boats on the Reeper Brans
Middle and latter part Fresh gale and
Rain Storm from S.W. Brig on the
Starboard tack So Ends
Lat Long

Thursday Aug 4
Comes With Squally Weather and
Moderate Winds Brig heading to the
North at 4 P.M. the Wind hall
near by Sail to the North and N.E. at 7 calm
Down 4 Sails in Sight Middle and latter
part the Same So Ends
Lat 37.13 Long 73.45

Friday Aug 5
Comes With light Winds from E.S.E.
and Clear Weather Brig heading N.E.
at 6 P.M. took in Sail and headed South
Middle part the Same latter part headed
E.S.E. all Sail out 2 Schooners in
Sight So Ends
Lat 37.05 Long 73.30
