

Sunday August 14 1887
 Comes With Good Breeze from N E and
 Clear Weather Brig heading West all sail
 out the Schooner in sight at 7 took in
 sail and headed to the North latter
 part headed S E all sail out some
 sperm Whales So Ends
 Lat 36 25 Long 73 36

Monday Aug 15
 Comes With light W E Winds and
 Clear Weather Brig heading S E at
 1 PM saw sperm Whales long the
 Boats and quit Fort S. B. W. B.
 quit two Whales at 6 quit the Whales
 to the Brig and headed to the North
 latter part cut the Whales in and
 headed to the N W Spoke the Alceone
 and came on with Squaler So Ends
 Lat 36 40 Long 73 55

Tuesday Aug 16
 Comes With Squally Weather and Strong
 S W Winds Brig heading N W Under
 Short Sail and Barling Middle and
 latter part the same So Ends
 Lat 36 40 Long 73 57

Wednesday Aug 17
 Comes With calm and Cloudy Weather
 at 4 PM Breeze up from the North
 N E Brig by the Wind on Port
 Tack and Boiling 2 Sails in sight
 Middle part quit three Boiling latter
 part saw the Oil Cann Brig heading
 South all sail out put letters Board
 Schooner Bound to Philadelphia Anna
 L. Mulford So Ends
 Lat 36 25 Long 74 20

Thursday August 18 1887
 Comes With light East Winds and
 Clear Weather Brig heading South all
 sail out 3 Sails in sight at 7 PM
 took in sail and Load Back Middle part
 the same Rain Storm Wind S W latter
 part headed on different Tacks 3 Whalers
 in sight So Ends
 Lat 36 32 Long 74 30

Friday Aug 19
 Comes With Strong S W Wind and
 Hazy Weather at 5 PM came with
 Rain Thunder and Lightning Brig
 heading off N E Under Short Sail
 took up the Boats Middle and latter part
 the same So Ends
 Lat 36 48 Long 73 58

Saturday Aug 20
 Comes With light air from South
 and Hazy Weather Brig heading
 to the Eastward all sail out at 7 took
 in sail Middle part Wind S S W
 latter part came to Blow Hurricane
 the Wind drove the Brig down East Under
 all Tack Water on the Fore Topmast Back
 Stays Parted and we cut the other one
 to let the mast go to Right the vessel
 up the Water not Lay by the Wind was
 obliged to Run her before the Wind
 S E at 12 the Mast went Over Brig heading
 N W and North Barometer 28.20
 So Ends
