Monday March 18th 1833 Long by Acc 63-34 Lat by Acc 54-06	Commences with light winds from the S.W. Steered S by E at 2 P.M. set the studding sails saw a number of fin backs Middle part Moderate Latter calm at 3 A.M. saw the Island of Terradelfugo Dist 22 miles at 4 A.M. sounded and got 65 fathoms More ship and stood off to S by E so Ends
Tuesday March 19th 1833 Lat by Acc 54-14 Long by Acc 64-56	Commences with light winds from the S.W. at 4 P.M. strong gales close reefed the Top sails and Steered S by E at 6 P.M. took in the Mizzen Top sails and Mainsail at 8 P.M. at 4 A.M. sounded and got 40 fathoms of water but found no bottom the Steered S by E at 6 A.M. set the Top sails
Wednesday March 20th 1833 Lat by Obs 54-04 Lat by Acc 54-06 Long by Obs 62-42 Long by Acc 62-06	First part light airs and calms at 5 P.M. took a Breeze from the S.W. than wore ship and ran by up S.W. at 11 P.M. wore ship again and by up S by E at 4 P.M. wore again and by up N by E at 5 A.M. took in the Fore and Mizzen Top sails and Courses than by too under Close Reefed Main Top sail Steady Sails so Ends with strong from the W.S.W.
Thursday March 21st 1833 Lat by Obs 54-45 Lat by Acc 54-56 Long by Obs 62-23 Long by Acc 62-19	Commences with Strong Gales from the S.W. West attended with heavy squalls of hail and snow at 11 P.M. wore ship and by up S by E Middle part more moderate Latter part light winds at 5 A.M. set the jib and Main sail and Close Reef Fore and Mizzen Top sails and wore ship the wind more to the South by up West by South at 4 out reef of Courses and one Reef of the Fore and Mizzen and 2 Reef of the Main Top sail and set the Top Gallant sail so Ends
Friday March 22nd 1833 Lat by Obs 55-07 Long by Acc 62-19	Commences with Moderate Breezes and pleasant weather out 2 Reef of the Top sails at 12 P.M. wore ship by up S by E Middle squally at 3 P.M. in 3rd Reef of the Fore and Mizzen Top sails and in jib an Close Mizzen Latter part much the same at 5 A.M. wore ship again and by up S by South so Ends with squally weather set the jib and Top sail

Saturday March 23rd 1833 Lat by Obs 55-04 Lat by Account 55-16 Long by Obs 63-15 Long by Account 63-15	Commences with squally weather and strong breezes from the S.W. by up from S.W. to S by W at 4 P.M. in Close Reef of the Fore and Mizzen and 2nd Reef of Main Top sail saw a number of sperm whales at 5 P.M. in jib at 6 P.M. wore ship again and by up S.E. at 11 P.M. in 3rd Reef of the Main Top sail and in Mainsail Middle part heavy squalls of wind and rain at 2 A.M. in Fore and Mizzen Top sails Latter part at 7 P.M. wore ship and by up West and set the reefed Mainsail at 11 A.M. set the Close reefed Fore and Mizzen Top sails and jib so Ends with squally weather
Sunday March 24th 1833 Lat by Obs 55-30 Lat by Acc 55-56 Long by Obs 63-23 Long by Acc 63-26	Commences with strong winds from the S.W. attended with squalls of rain at 7 P.M. out 1 Reef of the Fore and Mizzen Top sails and wore ship by up South at 2 P.M. More moderate out reef of the Fore sail Middle part much the same the wind veered to the N.W. out 2nd Reef of the Top sails and set the Main Top Gallant sail and out Reef of the Main sail and Steered S.W. Latter part fine Breeze from the S.W. at 5 A.M. out Reefs of the Top sails and set the Fore Top Mast and Main Top Gallant Studding sail and saw the Island of Staten at 9 A.M. the West point Bon Vly and at 10 A.M. the East point bore N.W. 3/4 N at 12 O'clock lost sight of the land so Ends
Monday March 25th 1833 Lat by Obs 56-38 Lat by Acc 56-58 Long by Obs 63-38 Long by Acc 63-38	Commences with Moderate winds from the S.W. Steered S.W. at 2 P.M. the wind more to the West in Studding sails and Main Top Gallant sail and one Reef of the Fore and Mizzen Top sails some squalls of wind and rain at 5 P.M. squally weather in one Reef of the Main Top sail at 5 P.M. strong winds in 3rd Reef of the Top sails and in jib and Main sail and in Reef of the Fore sail and in Mizzen at 9 P.M. more moderate out one Reef of the Top sails and set the Reefed Mainsail Middle part much the same out reef of the Fore sail and set the jib Latter part light winds out 2nd Reef of the Top sail and set the Main Top Gallant sail out Reef of the Main sail and set the Mizzen the wind from the N.W. Steered S by E so Ends
Tuesday March 26th 1833 Lat by Obs 57-21	Commences with Moderate winds from the S.W. Steered S.W. at 4 P.M. the wind from the S.W. at 3 P.M. out Fore Top Mast Studding sail Middle part much the same Latter part at 5 the wind from the S.W. Steered S by E and by up S.E. and in 2nd Reef of the Top sails and Main Top Gallant
