of the Fore Top Sail at 6 A.M. more moderate  
out Top Gallant sail so Ends steered N by W

Sail latter part more moderate out 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Reef of the Fore and Main Top Sails so Ends  
with thick weather and no observation

Commences with strong winds from the E by S  
steered N by W out Fore Top Mast and Main  
Top Gallant Studding sails and in jib  
Middle part light winds latter part much the  
same out 3<sup>rd</sup> Reef of the Main Top sail and 2<sup>nd</sup> Reef  
of the Whizzer Top Sail so Ends
