Commenced with brisk wind and pleasant weather saw nothing from aloft at 6 P.M. shortened sail and wore ship by up shy of Mizzen and latter part the same saw nothing from aloft so ends

Tuesday
February
18th 1854
Lat 5° 19' S
Long 129° 10' W
Commenced with brisk wind at 4 P.M. saw sperm whale of size weather quarter tacked ship at 5 P.M. lowered 3 boats and chased water sunset got none came on board and took up the boats and shortened sail Mizzen part the same latter part pleasant weather saw nothing Employed variously so ends

Wednesday
February
19th 1854
Lat 4° 44' S
Long 129° 04' W
Commenced with brisk wind at 4 P.M. tacked to the N.E. saw nothing at 6 P.M. in jibe and spanker and 2nd Reel of the Fore Gaff sail at 7 P.M. squally with rain took in 2nd Reel of the Main Top sail and in Main sail Mizzen part brisk wind latter part the same winds attended with heavy showers of rain saw nothing so ends

Thursday
February
20th 1854
Lat 5° 25' S
Long 129° 33' W
Commenced with strong wind and squally with rain at 9 P.M. wore ship and tacked South by E at 6 P.M. in Main sail Mizzen part the same latter part set the Main sail any jib saw nothing variously employed so ends

Friday
February
21st 1854
Lat 5° 58' S
Long 129° 37' W
Commenced with brisk wind and pleasant weather at 5 P.M. wore ship and by up N.E. saw nothing from aloft Mizzen part at 12 P.M. wore ship latter part at 5 P.M. wore back again saw nothing so ends

22nd 1854
Lat 5° 45' S
Long 129° 25' W
Commenced with brisk wind and pleasant weather saw porpoise at 6 P.M. shortened sail Mizzen part the same latter part wore ship again saw nothing so ends

Sunday
February
23rd 1854
Lat 6° 42' S
Long 129° 30' W
Commenced with Moderate Breezes and pleasant weather saw nothing from aloft at 6 P.M. shortened sail Mizzen part wore ship again latter part saw nothing so ends

Monday
February
24th 1854
Lat 6° 42' S
Long 129° 00' W
Commenced with brisk wind and pleasant weather saw nothing from aloft at 6 P.M. shortened sail to 3 top sails single reef at Mizzen part the same latter part made sail saw nothing so ends

Tuesday
February
25th 1854
Lat 12° 41' S
Long 129° 41' W
Commenced with brisk wind and pleasant weather saw nothing heading to the Southward and Westward at 6 P.M. shortened sail latter part made sail saw nothing so ends

Wednesday
February
26th 1854
Lat 6° 35' S
Long 130° 30' W
Commenced with brisk wind by up shy of Mizzen part the same latter part made sail saw nothing at 10 A.M. stored N.E. so ends variously employed on board

Thursday
February
27th 1854
Lat 5° 20' S
Long 130° 47' W
Commenced with Moderate wind saw nothing steering S by W at 4 P.M. shortened sail Mizzen part the same latter part (have sail saw nothing from aloft so ends

Friday
February
28th 1854
Lat 5° 47' S
Long 131° 00' W
Commenced with Strong Breezes and pleasant weather saw nothing from aloft at 4 P.M. shortened sail Mizzen part the same latter part made sail saw nothing by up shy of so ends

Saturday
March
1st 1854
Lat 2° 54' S
Long 128° 53' W
Commenced with brisk wind by up shy of saw nothing at 6 P.M. shortened sail Mizzen part squally latter part pleasant weather all variously employed on board so ends

Sunday
March
2nd 1854
Lat 1° 41' S
Long 130° 30' W
Commenced with Moderate winds and pleasant weather saw nothing from aloft Mizzen and latter part the same heading up N.E. so ends these twenty four hours

Monday
March
3rd 1854
Lat 2° 20' S
Long 131° 4' W
Commenced with Moderate wind and pleasant weather at 6 P.M. shortened sail Mizzen part the same latter part made sail by up N.E. saw nothing from aloft so ends
