Dec 2nd
1834
Commenced with brisk winds from the East by up 800 Mide and latter part the same so ends 3 58 155 21
- Wednesday
Dec 3rd
1834
Commenced with strong winds and clear weather employed in cooping oil Mide part strong increasing. Brees latter part took in the jib and spanker and 2 reef of the Top Sails so ends 2 11 155 30
- Thursday
Dec 4th
1834
Commenced with strong winds from the Eastward by up 8 by 6 Mide part out the jib and spanker latter part out 2 reef of the Top Sails so ends with brisk winds 155 12
- Friday
Dec 5th
1834
Commenced with strong winds and clear weather at 5 PM set the Main Top Gallant sail Mide part the same latter part saw the Amethyst Astoria so ends 155 45
- Saturday
Dec 6th
1834
Commenced with Moderate wind by up 8 by 6 at 2 PM spoke the Amethyst Mide and latter part fine weather saw nothing from in company with the Amethyst 155 47
- Sunday
December 7th
1834
Commenced with brisk winds by up 8 by 6 Mide part the same latter part saw killers so ends with fine weather 155 56
- Monday
Dec 8th
1834
Commenced with Moderate winds in company with the Amethyst Mide part the same latter part employed in stowing down so ends there 26 hours 155 56
- Tuesday
December 9th
1834
Commenced with Moderate winds at 3 PM finished stowing down Mide and latter part by up 8 by 6 so ends 155 56
- Wednesday
Dec 10th
1834
Commenced with Moderate winds and pleasant weather saw nothing from aloft in company with the Amethyst Mide part the same latter part squally attended with some rain saw 155 30

- Thursday
Dec 11th
1834
Commenced with strong winds and squally in Mainsail and 2 reef of the Top Sails Mide part the same latter part set the Main sail employed in mending the jib so ends 155 22
- Friday
Dec 12th
1834
Commenced with strong winds by up 8 by 6 employed in shifting warren from foreward aft in the Lower hold at 6 PM tacked ship by up 8 by 6 Mide part the same latter part tacked ship again employed in repairing the jib so ends
- Saturday
Dec 13th
1834
Commenced with brisk wind at 6 PM wore ship and spoke the Amethyst Mide part tacked again latter part the same winds saw nothing employed in making a jib so ends
- Sunday
Dec 14th
1834
Commenced with brisk winds from the Eastward by up on our starboard tack until 6 PM and then tacked ship by up 8 by 6 Mide part the same latter part Moderate winds and pleasant so ends
- Monday
Dec 15th
1834
Commenced with light winds Mide and latter part the same saw one piece of squid so end sent out the jib jib down and went the jib
- Tuesday
Dec 16th
1834
Commenced with light wind and pleasant weather at 6 PM took in the light sails and Main sail Mide part the same latter part set all sail and stored best saw porpoises so ends
- Wednesday
Dec 17th
1834
Commenced with light air stored Mide with all sail set at 6 PM took in the light sails and courses Mide part the same latter part set all sail stored Mide saw nothing from aloft so ends 155 15
