Good breeze from the S W
Steering E By S. Watch emp-
loyed doing Ships duty
Saw one fin back. So ends
this day Lat 29° 50'
Long 70° 58'

Wednesday Jan 11th

Strong breeze from the
Southward Steering E by S.
Saw two sails. Watch employees
doing Ships duty So ends this day
Lat 29° 34'
Long 68° 02'

Thursday Jan 12

Strong wind from N. N. E
Steering by the wind East.
Brig heaving 200 strokes
an hour on the Port tack
So ends this day
Lat 29° 19' n
Long 66° 12' w

Friday Jan 13th

Strong breeze from the Eastward
Head wind. Brig heaves some-
times 200 strokes an hour and
sometimes less. Pumps every two
hours. So ends this day
Lat 28° 30' n
Long 64° 03' w

Sat Jan 14th

Strong breeze from the East-
ward Pumped every two hours
Does not back so back on
the Starboard tack Watch
employed doing Ships duty
So ends this day
Lat 28° 48' n
Long 63° 13' w

Jan 15th Sunday

Light easterly wind Brig
making very little headway
on her course. Saw one sail
passed a large stick of timber
Pumps attended to. So ends this day
Lat 29° 20' n
Long 63° 32' w
