Remarks of a whaling voyage

on board

Saturday June 30th

Rainy squally weather.	Took on
board 20 bbl of flour, 15	barrel of
Beef, 10 barrel of Pork, 4	barrel of
Sugar, 1 barrel of Molasses,	2 barrel tar
Two kegs of salter salt	none
And two bags of Okra	none

Sunday July 1

At anchor at Barba was
 Clear pleasant weath er So
 ends this day

Monday July 2nd

At anchor at Bar bad weather
 All hands employed at
 getting the Brig ready for
 sea.

Tuesday July 3rd

At anchor at Bar bad weather
 Broke out Beef and
 water to ends the day

Wednesday July 4th

At anchor at Bar bad weather
 At anchor 11 P.M. took our
 anchor shaped our course for
 Dominica. Ernest. carefully shaped
 to day at fore mast handed.
 Clear Pleasant wea ther
 So ends this day

Thursday July 5th

This day begins with clear Pleasant
 weather. At 6 P.M. Dominica
 was seen one point on the Starboard
 bow. At dark Lufft to on the
 Port tack with the Head yards aback.
 So ends this day.

Friday July 6th

At 1.30 A.M. left off for Dominica
 Very light winds and calms prevailed
 most of the day. Anchored at Dom-
 inica at 7.30 P.M. in 5 fathoms
 of water with 30 fathoms of water.
 So ends this day.

Sat July 7th

At anchor at Dominica. Rainy equal-
 ly weather. All hands employed at
 setting up shacks and getting casks
 ready for rafting water. Took 8 casks
 on shore rolled them up on the beach
 and left them their empty. So ends
 this day.

Sunday July 8th

At anchor at Dominica
 Clear Pleasant weather
 So ends this day
