Friday Aug 24th

Light variable wind. Latter part
raining. Broke out the ground
tier for a leaky cask Broke
out water flour Bread Sugar
and Molasses four sails in
sight - so ends this day.

Sat Aug 25th

Moderate N.E. wind One sail
in sight - So ends this day

Lat 32° 12' N
Long 35° 09' W

Sunday Aug 26th

Strong East wind all day
Nothing but Porpoise in sight
So ends this day

Lat 33° 08' N
Long 33° 01' W

Monday Aug 27th

Strong Easterly wind. Saw many
Porpoises and no whaler.
Frequent rain squalls So ends
this day

Lat 34° 05' N
Long 33° 13' W

Tuesday Aug 28th

Strong Easterly wind Saw Grampus
So ends this day

Lat 34° 16' N
Long 34° 52' W

Wednesday Aug 29th

Light S.E. Wind Clear Pleasant
weather Many Grampus and Por-
poise in sight - Pump attended
to as usual. So ends this day

Lat 35° 12' N
Long 34° 06' W

Thursday Aug 30th

Moderate S.E. Wind. Saw many
Grampus and Porpoise. One sail
in sight. So ends this day

Lat 37° 11' N
Long 34° 30' W

Friday Aug 31st

Moderate S.E. Wind. One sail in
sight - Sperm whaler one rather
scarce So ends this day

Lat 38° 22' N
Long 35° 32' W

Sat Sept 1st

Light S.E. wind Two merchant
vessels in sight. So ends this day

Lat 38° 36' N
Long 34° 25' W

Sunday Sept 2nd

Light Easterly wind Saw Grampus
Porpoise. Cowfish. Blackfish
and six sails. So ends
this day

Lat 38° 00' N
Long 35° 11' W
