Monday Sept 10th

Variable wind. Nothing in sight.
Employed at Ship's duty to end
this day. Lat 37° 14' N
Long 34° 12' W

Tuesday Sept 11

Strong S.W. Wind. Employed
mending by sail. Nothing in sight.
To end this day. Lat 37° 49' N
Long 34° 45' W

Wednesday Sept 12

Strong S.W. Wind with much
rain. Nothing in sight. To end this day.
Lat 37° 41' N
Long No Obs

Thursday Sept 13th

Moderate norwesterly gale
Nothing in sight. To end this day
Lat 37° 37' N
Long 32° 26' W

Friday Sept 14th

Strong northerly wind. Saw a
large school of Black fish
going quick to the leeward. Did
not lower. Broke out water
Lat 37° 37' N
Long 31° 04' W

15th

Moderate northerly breeze. Nothing
in sight. To end this day. Lat 37° 26' N
Long 30° 05' W

Sunday Sept 16

Very light north-ly wind. Nothing in
sight. To end this day. Lat 37° 30' N
Long 30° 36' W

Monday Sept 17th

Begins with northerly wind. with fre-
quent rain squalls. Nothing in sight.
Broke out Beef. Pork. Bread. and
flour. Latter part calm. To end
this day. Lat 38° 00' N
Long 29° 48' W

Tuesday Sept 18th

Calm all day. Many Porpoise in sight.
Rove new port-Beam sheet. and
new fore sheet. Picked up a yellow
pine stick of 22
and 22 inches square and cut it
up for fire wood. To end this day
Lat 37° 44' N
Long 29° 03' W

Wednesday

Sept 19th

Begins with a strong breeze from the S
lighted by a light. To end this day. Lat 32° 34' N
Long 28° 34' W
Ends with a gale from the S. Lat 32° 14' N
