

Remarks of a Whaling voyage on board

Friday Sept 28th

Begins with a moderate gale from the S.W. With frequent rain squalls. Passed the island of Terceira. Later part a little better weather. Pump attended to as usual. Scendell's day.
Lat 39° 05' N
Long 23° 57' W

Sat Sept 29th

Begins with a light breeze from the westward. At 7 A.M. weather fair. Point of St. Michael Bore off by S. distance 25 miles. Ends with a calm.

Sunday Sept 30th

Begins with light westerly wind. Latter part squally and variable.

Monday 2 A.M. wind veered to the N.W. Kept off for St. Michael. Anchored at 1 P.M. Moved the vessel, head and stern. Finished at seven P.M. So ends this day.

Tuesday Oct 1st

At anchor at St. Michael. Employed at washing the outside of the vessel. Breaking out beef and water and doing other jobs.

Wednesday Oct 3rd

At anchor at St. Michael. Took off several sheets of copper to find the leak on the Starboard side of the vessel. Also took on shore the Iron work on the jib backropes. to be repaired. and doing other jobs. So ends this day.

Thursday Oct 4th

Pumped out salt water to make room for fresh. So ends this day.

Friday Oct 5th

At anchor at St. Michael. All hands employed doing shape duty. Steward went on shore to the Hospital. Ben Hazard was put into the storeroom from the cabin.

Sat Oct 6th

At anchor at port of St. Michael. All hands employed at taring down. And doing other jobs. So ends this day.

Sunday Oct 7th

All hands on shore for Liberty. So ends this day.
