

Remarks of a whaling voyage on board

Monday Oct 8th

At anchor at St Michael
 All hands except Joe Gomez came
 on board in good time.
 Employed at setting up the
 bowsprit shrouder, jib jammers
 Back ropes and guys. Took the
 chain plate on shore that parted
 out to sea to be mended
 So ends this day

Tuesday Oct 9th

At anchor at St Michael
 Joe Gomez came on board at
 11 A.M. Two men came to
 Repair the vessel. Taped the
 Brig town by the head to the caulke-
 er could repair the stern.
 Bolled the Starboard boat over ready
 for painting and did other jobs
 So ends this day

Wednesday Oct 10th

At anchor at St Michael
 Caulkers at work on the
 Brig on the Starboard side
 All hands employed heeling
 the vessel one way and the
 other so the caulkers could
 work and doing other jobs
 So ends this day

Interwood still on shore at
 the Hospital

At anchor at St Michael
 Very rainy. Caulkers worked half
 a day. So ends this day

Friday Oct 12th

At anchor at St Michael
 Caulkers worked all day.
 All hands employed doing
 Spifs duty. Painted the Starboard
 boat So ends this day

Sat Oct 13th

At anchor at St Michael
 Caulkers at work. Put the
 Forward Port main chain plate
 in its place and set up
 the rig in, and did other
 jobs So ends this day

Sunday Oct 14th

At anchor at St Michael
 Very stormy bad weather So
 ends this day

Monday 15th

At anchor at St Michael
 Painted the Starboard boat
 Caulkers did not work on
 account of rough weather
 So ends this day
