Remarks of a whaling Voyage on board

Tuesday Oct 16th

At anchor at St Michael
Caulkers at work on the vessel
All hands employed doing Ship's
duty. So ends this day

Wednesday Oct 17th

At anchor at St Michael
Caulkers still at work
So ends this day

Thursday Oct 18th

At anchor at St Michael
Caulkers at work. All hands
employed doing sundry jobs
So ends this day.

Friday Oct 19th

At anchor at St Michael
Caulkers at work. So ends
this day. Took on board one
raft of water 55 barrels -

Sat Oct 20

At anchor at St Michael
Caulkers at work.
Took on board one
raft of water about
60 barrels
So ends this day

Sunday Oct 21st

At anchor at St Michael
Begins with a heavy gale of wind
so rough for the Caulkers to work
So ends this day

Monday Oct 22nd

Anchor at St Michael
Caulkers at work. Frequent
rain squalls So ends this day

Tuesday Oct 23rd

At anchor at St Michael
Caulkers at work took one
raft of water about 60 lbs
and finished filling the ground
tier with water. There is now
225 lbs of fresh water on board.
So ends this day

To Long Boat Flume
discharge the waterWednesday Oct 24th

At anchor at St Michael
Caulkers finished working
on the vessel to day. Commen-
ced painting Ship's so ends
this day.

Thursday Oct 25th

At anchor at St Michael
Caulkers finished worked
on the Brig. Painted part
of the Starboard Side of
the brig out side
