Friday Nov 16th

At Anchor at St Michael
Took on board 20 bushels of
Irish Potatoes and the same of
sweet. So ends this day

Sat Nov 17th

At anchor at St Michael
All hands employed
getting the Brig ready
for sea So ends this day

Sunday Nov 18

At anchor at St Michael
So ends this day

Monday Nov 19th

At anchor at St Michael
At 8 o'clock A.M. Began
to unmoor the vessel. Took
on board the chains on the
Starboard side fore and aft.
Took on board three quarters
of beef. And two Boat-loads
of wood. At 6 P.M. put out
the chains that were taken
in in the morning. So ends
this day.
