

Remarks of a Whaling Voyage on board

Sunday Jan 13th

Begins with a calm. Laying under the lee of St Antoine, Watch Employed Repairing the Foresail. Shifted ends with the fore and foretop sail bracer. Broke out water. Later part calm. Saw One Large Ship and one Brig. Mate went on shore after some Coffee but could not get any. So ends this day.

Monday Jan 14th

Begins with light variable winds. Boat come on board at 5 P.M. Saw one Steamer. Latter part Light North-erly wind. So ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 15th

Begins with light N.E. (Lat 17° 12' N trade winds) Saw a school Long 25° 44' W of Black fish toward the two port-boats but did not get fast.

Wednesday Jan 16th

Begins with Strong (Lat 18° 04' N N.E. Trade winds. Spoke Long 26° 16' W the Schooner E.H. Phillips of Provincetown. Also the Bark President of New Bedford. The Phillips saw a school of small whaler about four days past but did not get fast. Sperm whaler have not been seen here very ^{long} here this year. Lighted the Schooner Alvord of Provincetown. Later part wind more moderate. Nothing in sight. So ends this day.

Thursday Jan 16th

Begins with Light (Lat 18° 55' N N.E. Trade winds) Long 26° 44' W. Adn ends the same.

Friday Jan 17th

Begins with clear seas (Lat 19° 43' N) and weather. Light wind (Lon 27° 31' W) from N.E. Broke out Water & Flour. And one shot of towline to replace that used in fast. Pumps carefully attended to. Leaking same as usual. Latter part wind and weather the same.

Saturday Jan 18th

Begins with Light wind (Lat 19° 20' N) from the Eastward. Watch (Long 27° 05' W) employed making Spungum. Saw a large Linback. Later part wind a little stronger. Saw a Whaling Schooner trying out but could tell her name. So ends this day.

Sunday Jan 19th

Begins with moderate (Lat 18° 04' N) trade wind. Later wind (Long 26° 16' W) very strong. Saw one Whaling Schooner and two Merchant Vessels. So ends this day.

Monday Jan 20th

Begins with very Strong (Lat 17° 50' N) trade wind. Saw a school Long 26° 21' W of Drampur and one Linback. Later part wind the same. So ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 21st

Begins with strong trade (Lat 18° 55' N) wind. Rove new try-sail Long 26° 45' W sheet. Later part wind light.

Wednesday Jan 22

Begins with light (Lat 19° 50' N) Easterly wind. Many (Long 26° 50' N) Porpoise in sight. Later part calm. So ends this day.
