

Remarks of a whaling Voyage on board
Jan 23rd

Thursday

Begin with a calm (Lat $20^{\circ}22' N$
Broke out Beef, Pork. (Long $26^{\circ}32' W$
Water and Molasses Saw a large fin
back. Changed endr with the Larbord
and waist Boat falls. Later part
a light wind from the Southard
At 8 A.M. Blackfish were raised by
Cesar Brava. Lowered the two port
boats Waist Boat struck first.
Larbord boat struck soon after.
Each boat captured two. Antoine
Joseph Lowered in the head of the
Larbord boat and struck the black
fish. John Alvir is sick he has been
complaining of a cold in his chest.
For some time to day he is off duty
sick a bed. Lewis de Bourgo is off
duty sick with the Diareti. Saw a
large Merchant Vessel. So ends this
day

Friday Jan 24th

Begin with a Moderate Southerly
Breeze Cut up the Black (Lat $20^{\circ}34' N$
fish Manuel de Bourgo (Long $26^{\circ}20' W$
Cut his leg with an Iron.

Later part strong Southerly wind

Saw a Merchant Brig So ends this day
Sat Jan 25th

Begin with Strong (Lat $20^{\circ}34' N$
Southerly wind. Same (Long $23^{\circ}36' W$
men off duty sick Pumps attended
to as usual. Watch employed
cutting up Blackfish Blubber
Later part calm commenced
trying out. So ends this day

Sunday Jan 26th

Begin with a calm (Lat $24^{\circ}10' W$
Finished trying out (Long $21^{\circ}02' N$
Blackfish Later part Blackfish
were seen at daylight by Rufino Gonzales
Lowered the two port boats L B
struck first. Each boat got one.
Saw a Merchant vessel going to
the southard So ends this day

Monday Jan 27th

Begin with Moderate
N E trader. Later part (Lat
wind a little Stronger (Long
Saw two Steamers so ends this day

Tuesday Jan 28th

Begin with very (Lat $19^{\circ}23' N$
Strong N E trader (Long $23^{\circ}54' W$
Lewis de Bourgo returned on duty
John Alvir still off duty sick
Later part wind the same So ends this
day

Wed Jan 29th

Begin with very (Lat $18^{\circ}20' N$
strong Wind. Thick (Long $23^{\circ}31' W$
and smoky Nothing in sight
Later part the same So ends this day

Thursday Jan 30th

Begin with strong (Lat $27^{\circ}30' N$
N.E. trader. Very thick (Long $24^{\circ}04' W$
and smoky Nothing in sight Lewis
Manuel de Bourgo returned on duty.

Friday Jan 31st

Begin with strong (Lat $17^{\circ}39' N$
N.E. trader Boiled (Long $24^{\circ}57' W$
The Blackfish. Nothing in sight.
Later part very Moderate.
St. Antoine in sight. So ends
this day
