

Remarks of a Whaling Voyage on board

Friday March 14th

Begins with strong (Lat 13° 04' N
N.E. Trade winds (Long 44° 43' E
Saw a Finback. John Alvir still
off duty sick and growing worse
every day. Later part wind the same

Sat March 15th

Begins with strong (Lat 13° 18' N
N.E. wind. Nothing (Long 45° 52' W
in sight. Brig taking same as
usual. Later part the same so
ends this day.

Sunday March 16th

Begins with (Lat 12° 53' N
very strong N.E. (Long 49° 03' W
wind with frequent rain squalls
Later part wind more to the East-
ward. So ends this day.

Monday March 17th

Begins with strong easterly
wind. Later part (Lat 13° 52' N
wind veered to the (Long 51° 04' W
S.W. and rained very hard
for four hours. So ends this day

Tuesday March 18th

Begins with wind (Lat 13° 12' N
from the S.W. Very (Long 53° 19' W
squally. bad weather. Broke out
Beef & Water. Sugar and Flour.
Later part wind and rain the same
So ends this day

Wed March 19th

Begins with very (Lat 13° 27' N
light variable (Long no obs
winds with much rain.
Later part calm. Lowered the
two port boats for blackfish
want boat caught two

Thursday March 20th

Begins with a calm (Lat 13° 28' N
Pumps attended to (Long no obs W
as usual. Brig taking same as us-
ual. John Alvir still off duty sick
Later part very light Easterly wind
Nothing in sight So ends this day.

Friday March 21st

Begins with light (Lat 13° 20' N
Easterly wind Later (Long 55° 11' W
part the same

Sat March 22nd

Begins with very (Lat 13° 38' N
light easterly winds (Long 19° 19' W
And ends the same

Sunday March 23

Begins with light (Lat 13° 05' N
variable air. About (Long 57° 56' W
6 P.M. a strong breeze sprung up
from the N.E. and for an hour and
then fell to a calm. Later part
Calm. So ends this day

Monday March 24th

Begins with a calm. Later
part A strong breeze sprung
up from the N.E. Barbadoes
was seen at daylight. Anchored
in Carlisle bay at 10 A.M.

Tuesday March 25th

Lying at anchor at Barbadoes
Later part Broke out and put
in to a lighter 1500 galls of Sperm
and 345 galls of Blackfish. all
the casks in good condition
So ends this day. Rove a new
fish tackle fall.
