

Remarks of A Whaling voyage onboard

Frid Sept 27<sup>th</sup> 1889  
Commenced with fine weather Light  
S.W. Wind med part Calm me &  
Later part heavy gale from W. S.W.  
Under bare Poles standing before  
The wind steering S 30 E  
Lat by obs 36.21 N  
Long by Chron 73.03 W

Sat Sept 28<sup>th</sup> 1889  
Commenced with a gale from W  
Steering S by E under full sail  
Med & later part the same  
Lat by obs 34.11 N  
Long by Chron 72.30 W

Sunday Sept 29<sup>th</sup> 1889

Commenced with Light W Wind  
Steering S by E under all sail med  
Part the same at 2 P.M. Saw  
A School of Spinn whales toward  
So Boats Starboard Boat Struck whale  
Cut the line in his mouth and parted  
Went boat went on twice and boat  
Steerer mist boat time the boat came  
Onboard whale went to windward  
Lat 33.13 N Long 72.12 W

Monday Sept 30<sup>th</sup> 1889  
Commenced with fine weather Light  
Winds from E & S steering S med &  
Later part Winds E & S by E heading  
S & S by W employed in repairing  
fairsail at 4 P.M. bent the fairsail  
So Ends

Lat by obs 32.08 N  
Long by Chron 72.26 W

Brook the West boat  
Boat Steerer Olsen

Saw Whale went to windward

Tues Sept 30<sup>th</sup> 1889  
Commenced with Light Baffling winds  
from S.E heading S.W under all  
Sail med & later fine at 2 P.M.  
Saw a School of Spinn whales  
Toward Starboard & Starboard Boats  
Starboard Boat Struck & Saved the  
Whale took him along side at 3 P.M.  
Commenced cutting

Lat by obs 31.52 N  
Long by Chron 72.45 W

Wed Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 1889  
Commenced with fine weather Light  
S.W. winds med & later the same fine  
Cutting at 11 A.M. so Ends or obs

Thurs Oct 2<sup>nd</sup> 1889  
Commenced with fine weather Light  
Winds from S.W med part rainy weather  
Light W winds later part fine employed  
In Boiling so Ends there 24 hours  
Lat by obs 31.57 N  
Long by Chron 72.04 W

Friday Oct 3<sup>rd</sup> 1889  
Commenced with fine weather light E by S  
Wind ship heading S.E employed in boiling  
Med & later part winds North strong  
Breg finish boiling so Ends there 24  
hours  
Lat by obs 31.13 N  
Long by Chron 71.57 W

Sat Oct 4<sup>th</sup> 1889  
Commenced with strong N.E. Wind  
Steering S by E med & later the same  
Saw one Barque steering to the Westward  
So Ends there 24 hours  
Lat by obs 30.53 N  
Long by Chron 71.03 W
