Sunday Oct 27th 1889
Commenced with a strong Breeze from
South Ship heading NW by NE med part
Blowing a heavy gale with thunder
& lightning later part more moderate
Saw one bark & Schooner Steering E
Lat by obs 29.46 W
Long by Chor 75.46 W

Monday Oct 28th 1889
Commenced with moderate weather
Winds NW by W and light Ship heading W
Med & later fine so ends
Lat by obs 30.22
Long by Chor 76.13 W

Tuesday Oct 29th 1889
Commenced with fine weather
Heading to the Northward med &
later part fine so ends
Lat by obs 30.28 W
Long by Chor 75.52 W

Wed Oct 30th
Commenced with fine weather light
Westerly winds Steering to the
Eastward Med & later the same
Lat 29.50
Long 76.25

Thursday Oct 31st
Commenced with light Baffling
Winds me & later part calm
Lat 29.42
Long 76.10

Friday Nov 1st
Commenced with fine weather light Baffling winds
med part moderate winds from E & S Steering to
SW Saw 2 sails Lat 28.56 W
Long 76.59 W

Sat Nov 2nd
Commenced with fine weather strong winds from
SE Steering SW med & later weather the same
Lat 28.14 W
Long 78.00 W

Sunday Nov 3rd
Commenced with fine weather moderate
Winds from SE med & later calm Saw one
Steamer Steering to NE so ends
Lat by obs 28.16 W
Long by Chor 78.30 W

Monday Nov 4th
Commenced with fine weather light
Baffling winds med & later the same
Lat by obs 28.16 W
Long by Chor 78.15 W

Tuesday Nov 5th
Commenced with light Baffling winds
Med part fresh Breeze from E & S at 9 AM
Saw sperm whales at 10.30 Saw a
Searboid & west Boats whales very ship
Saw West Boat went on to the whale
When he was under the Rem of the Water
and started & galled him Searboid
Boat went on and made a good chance
Boats came on board at Sundown
Lat by obs 28.00 W
Long by Chor 78.12 W

Wed Nov 6th
Commenced with fine weather fresh Breeze from
E & S med & later the same
Lat 28.50
Long 78.45
