Looking Bad Commences with a gale from W.W.W.
With clear weather med & later the
same ship. Leaking very Bad pumps
at work every 2 hours
Lat 30.25 Long 75.25

Sat Nov 23rd
Looking Bad Commences with a moderate gale from
W.W. med & later the same. Weather clear
At 3 P.M. saw sperm whale at 4
leeward. To boats. Went, boat struck a large
whale saved him took the whale to the
brig at dark Lat 30.45 W Long 73.15 W

Sunday Nov 24th
Looking Bad Commences with fine weather light North
winds Employed in cutting med & later
the same Lat 30.45 Long 73.04

Monday Nov 25th
Commences with light Easterly winds
Employed in cutting later part fine & hot
Cutting Commenced boiling
Lat 30.26 W
Long 73.17 W

Tuesday Nov 26th
Commences with strong Easterly winds
Employed in boiling med & later
winds the same 30.24 W

Long 73.44 W

Looking Bad Commences with a strong S.E. wind

Looking Bad Commences with light Baine squalls med
& later fine Employed in boiling med & later
the same Lat 31.21 W
Long 73.59

Sat Nov 30th
Commences with fine weather light Westerly
winds Employed in stowing down oil
Saw one Bark steering to the Eastward
No Ob.

Sunday Dec 1st
Commences with fine fresh Breeze from
N.E. and rainy weather Saw 3 sails steering
to the North med & later weather the same.
No Ob.

Monday Dec 2nd
Commences with fresh N.E. Breeze and
clear weather Saw a steamer steering
North med and later fine
Lat 29.33 W
Long 72.54 W

Tuesday Dec 3rd
Commences with fine weather winds N.E.
And clear weather med & later the
same Lat 29.42 W
Long 72.45 W
