

Journal of the Whaling Brig Eunice H.

Tuesday September 6th 1893

Commence to break out the oil all hands employed at it Fine weather all the day with a light breeze from the westward

Wednesday 7th

In port. All hands employed breaking out the oil and coopers let sent ashore in a lighter at 11 A.M. ten casks of oil to be stored until the Bark arrive which is to take it home Fine weather and a moderate breeze

Thursday 7th

Finished breaking out the oil at 10 A.M. and sent it ashore by a lighter the rest of the day cleaning the hole and doing other jobs Fine weather and a light breeze

Friday 8th

Nothing of any consequence happening today Fine weather and a light breeze from the northward sent Joseph Brown to the hospital sick with venereal disease

Saturday 9th

In port The crew employed painting the yards and mast heads Fine weather all the day Had a carpenter from the shore taking out the broken chain plates of the Topgallant backstay

Sunday 10th

Went all of crew ashore enjoying themselves The weather equally the first part of the day but fair the balance Wind light from the southeast

Monday 11th

In port Finished painting the yards and other spars Weather cloudy and the wind to the eastward

Tuesday 12th

In port All hands with the exception of Mate and steward went ashore on liberty The whaling ship Pedro Parela arrived today full of oil

Wednesday 13th

In port All hands ashore still as they was given forty eight hours Discharge today Joseph Lopez a boatswain by mutual consent Weather fine and wind to the eastward

Thursday 14th

In port All hands aboard today broke out the hole for provisions Also bent the square sails and mainsail ~~also~~ ^{and} repaired the latter Wind east and weather fine Shipped Emanuel Brown a boatswain and he went to work today

Friday 15th

In port All hands pumping water out of the casks in the hole as it was bad then 2 P.M. sent the boat ashore with three and brought them off The wind to the southward and the weather fine The shipkeeper went to the hospital sick with venereal disease

Saturday 16th

In port Raising water all the day Put Alexander Allen in irons for being drunk and disorderly Wind north east and the weather fine
